

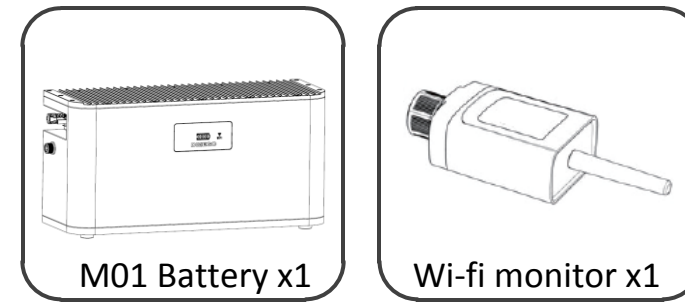
# Wi-fi Monitor Quick Guide

--M01 Lithium-ion Battery

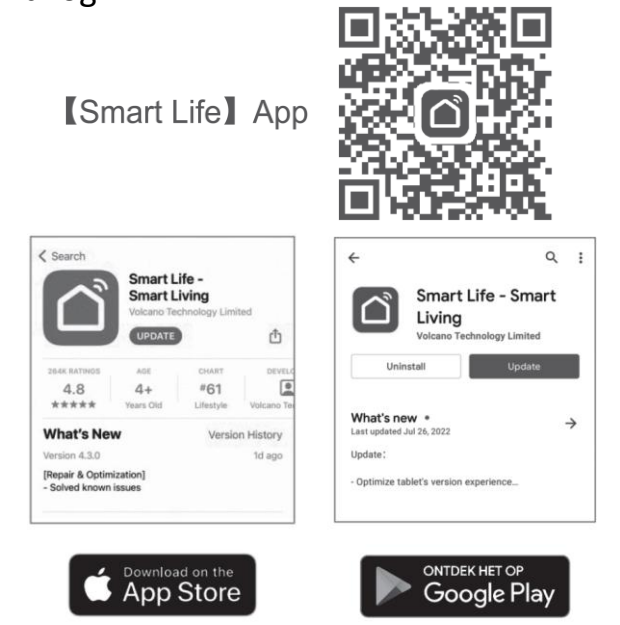
## I Installation Preparation

Note: The Wi-fi monitor guide briefly describes required operation steps. If you have any questions during the installation, please consult manufacturer for more detailed information.

- Get the M01 battery and Wi-fi monitor ready

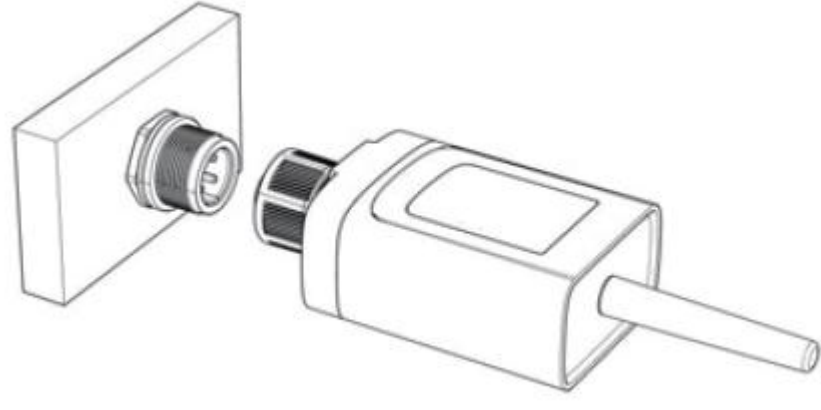

## II Wi-fi Monitor Installation

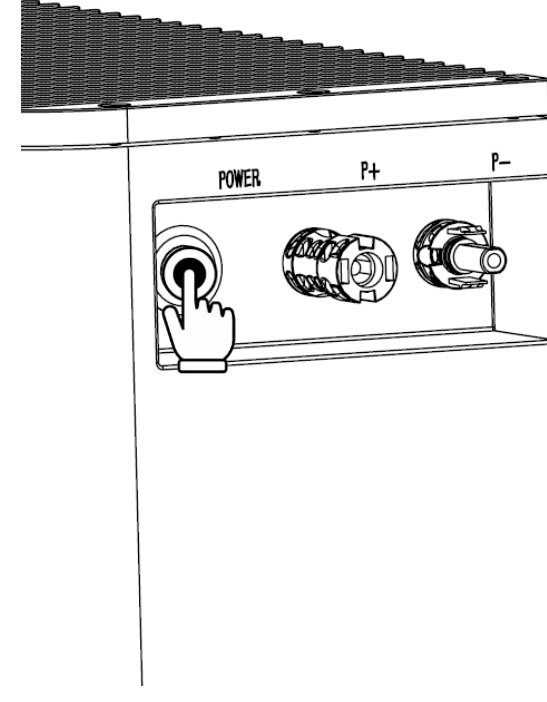
- unscrew the protective cap of the 4-core COM communication port of the device, align the gap, and plug in the communication stick. Tighten the nut to make sure the communication stick is in good contact with the device.



**Notice** When disassembling, please loosen the nut, and then pull out the communication stick. Do not directly turn the body of the communication stick with force, so as not to damage the communication stick.

## III Wi-fi Config and Login

- Press power button, and communication stick will enter the network distribution state.



Wi-fi indicator status

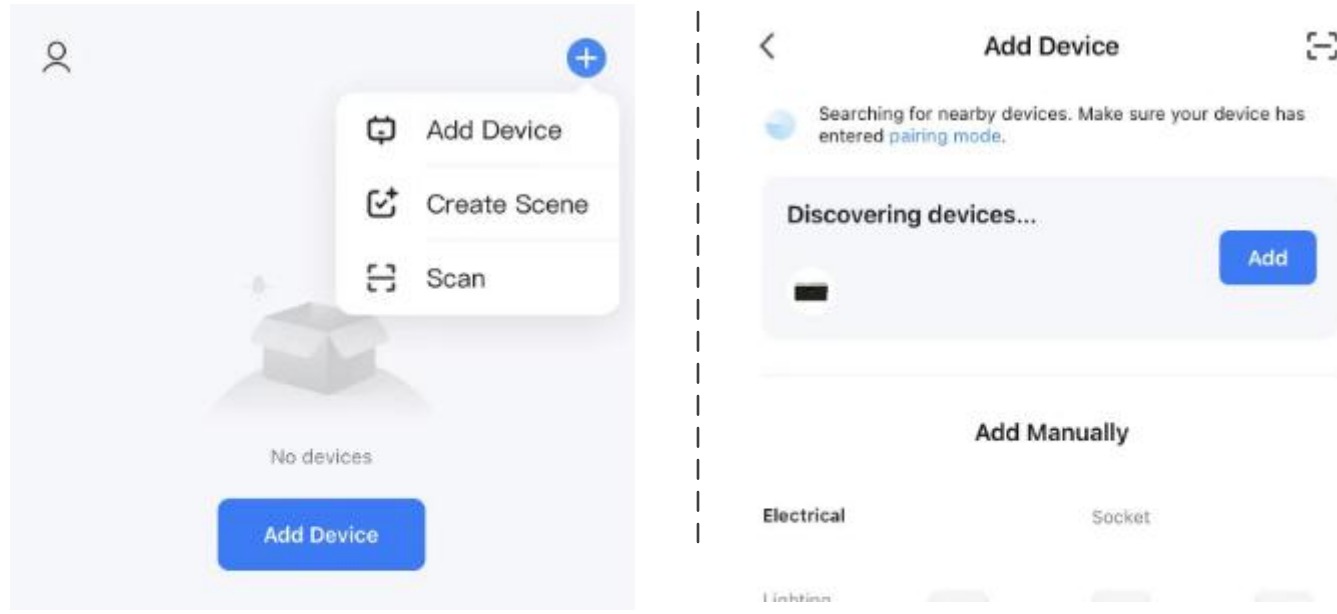
Wi-fi monitor status	Wi-fi indicator status
Network distribution	Flash every 0.25S
Normal	Flash every 1S
Offline	Flash five times every 0.25S interval and flash five times 1S interval(Continuous cycle)

**Notice** 1.Please make sure your phone is connected to Wi-fi.  
2.Please make sure your bluetooth is on.  
3.Please make sure your APP has access to location information.

## III Wi-fi Config and Login

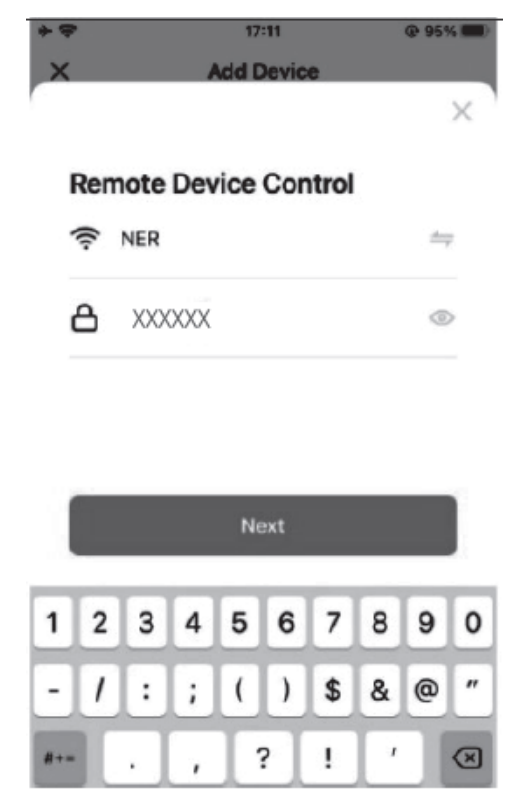
- When the communication stick is powered on at the first time, it is in the state of waiting for network distribution by default. Turn on the bluetooth on the mobile phone, enter the APP. There are two ways to add device as below:

- 1) click the "+" in the upper right corner, and select "Add Device".
- 2) APP automatically discovers the device to be added, click ADD.



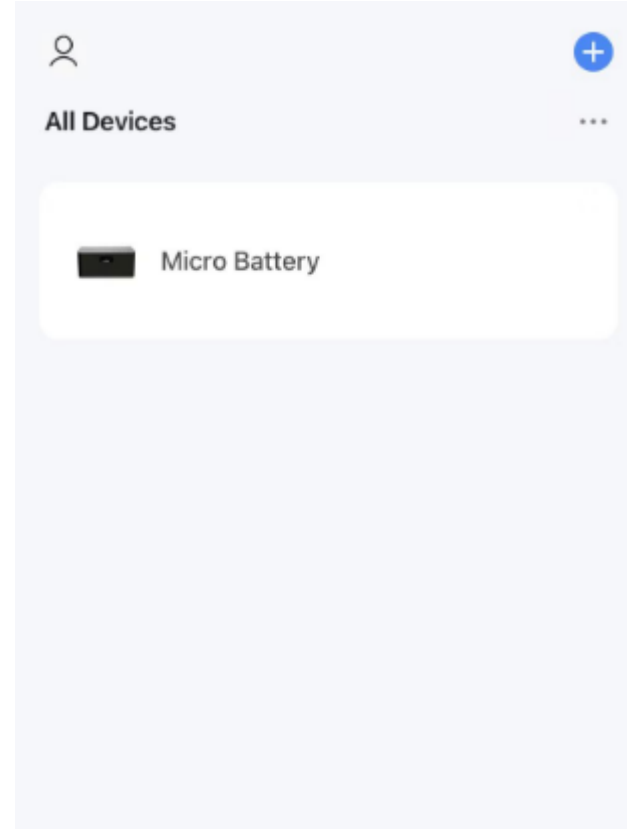
## III Wi-fi Config and Login

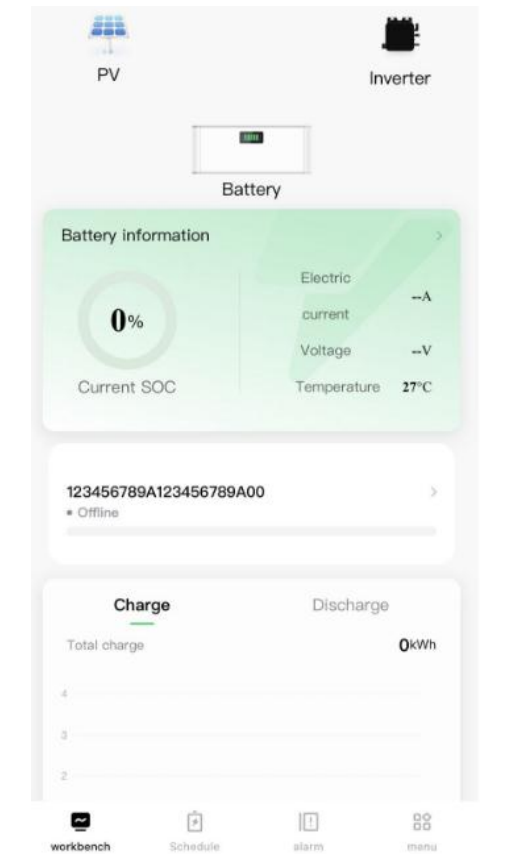
- After completion, enter the device panel to view the data.



## IV Operation Instruction

### 1. Workbench

- Display device working status, SOC, voltage, current, temperature information. You can click on the curve to view the charge and discharge curves for different days, weeks, months, and year.



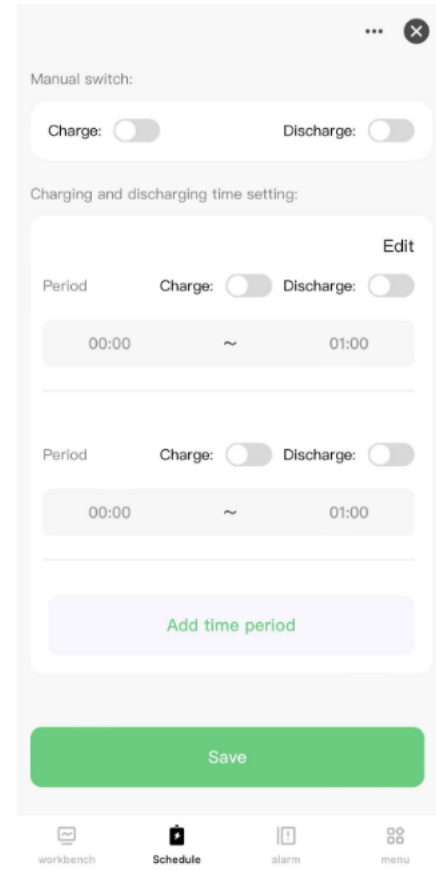
## IV Operation instruction

### 2. Schedule

- The charging and discharging of the device has two modes: manual switch, charging and discharging time setting. The manual switch has priority over the timed charging and discharging function.

-Only when the manual switch is turned off can the timed charging and discharged function be set. The user can "add" and "edit" the time period according to actual needs.

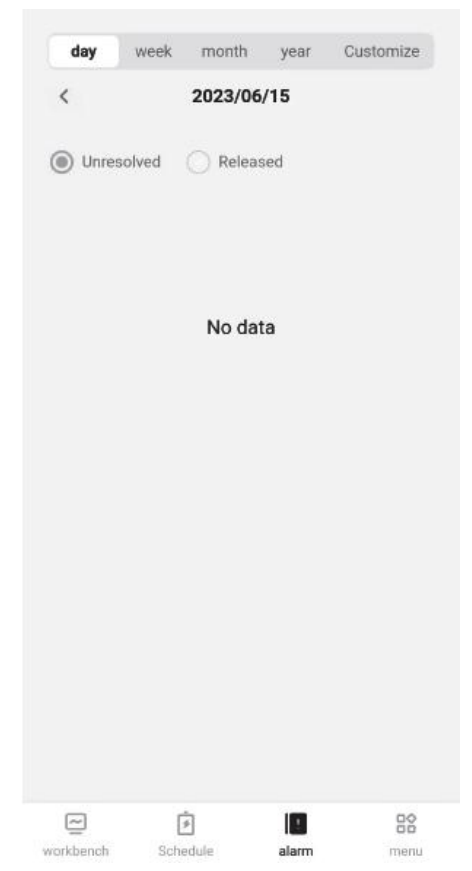
**Notice** The time ranges do not overlap at different time periods.

### 3. Alarm

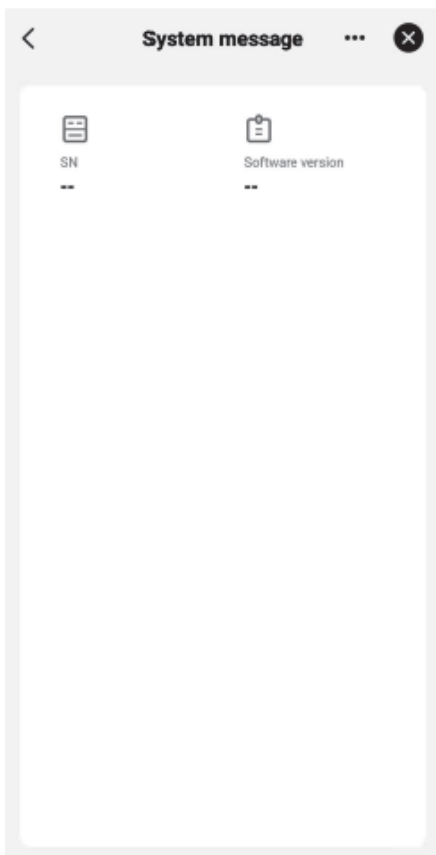
- Display the alarm information from the device.



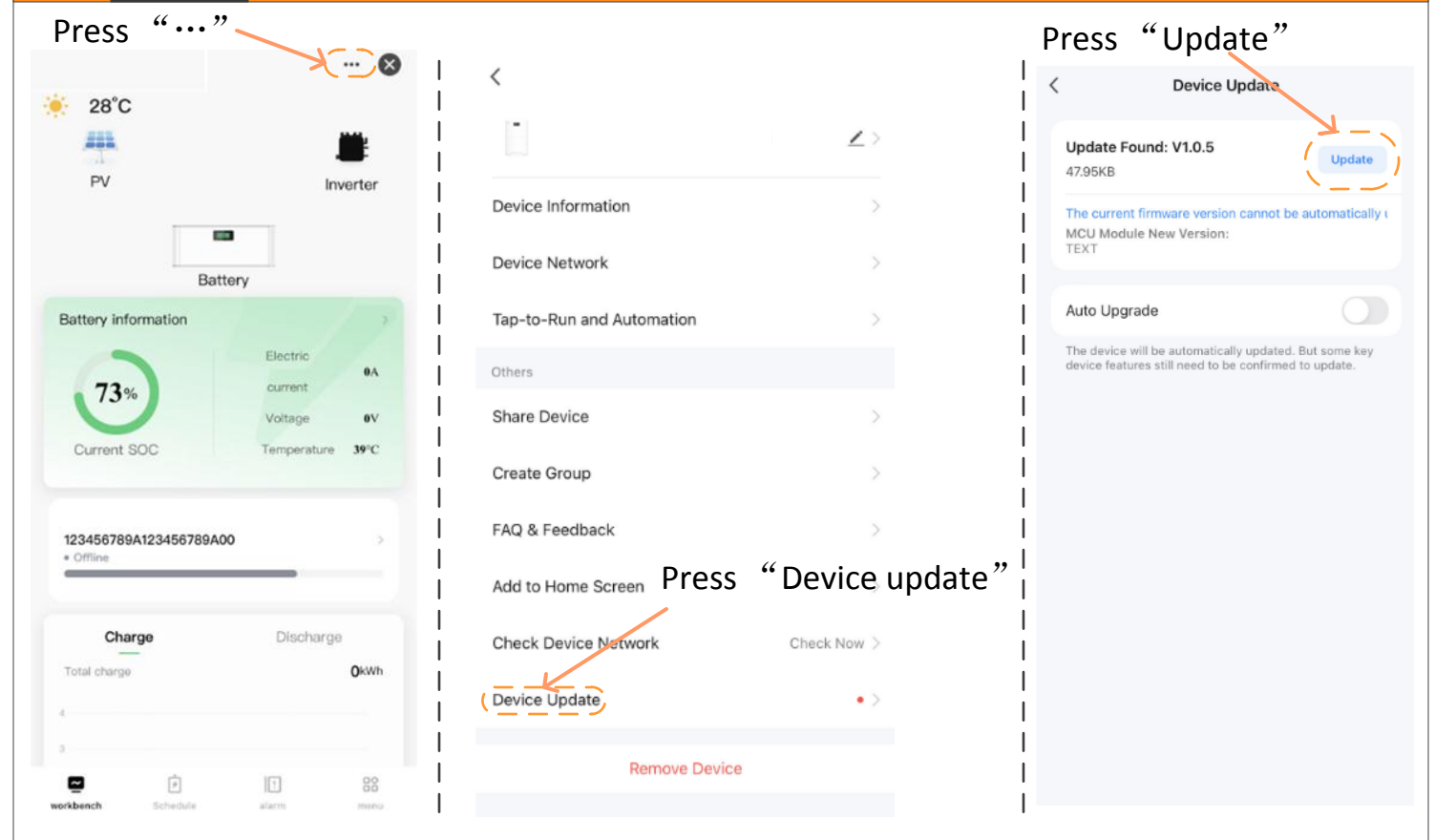

- Display the SN number and software version information of the device

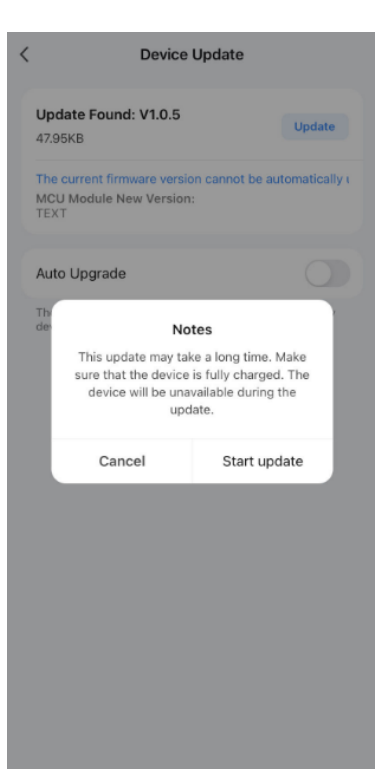

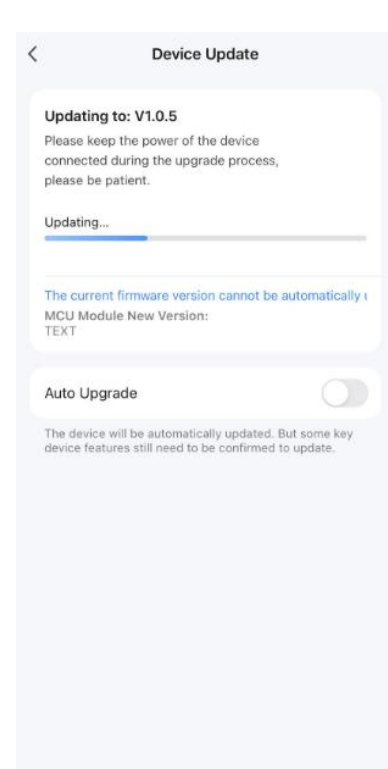
